The AWOC was developed from the Korea-Japan Workshop on Ocean Color (KJWOC) initiated by Joji Ishizaka (Nagasaki University, presently Nagoya University, Japan) and Yu-Hwan Ahn (Korea Ocean Research and Development Institute, presently Korea Institute of Ocean Science and Technology, Korea) in 2003. During AWOC, I gave an oral presentation in the session of "Ocean Color Monitoring for Harmful Environments". It was my first time to give oral presentation at AWOC, so I was a
